Shoebbox Collection Deadline Sunday, Nov 12th ~ Noon

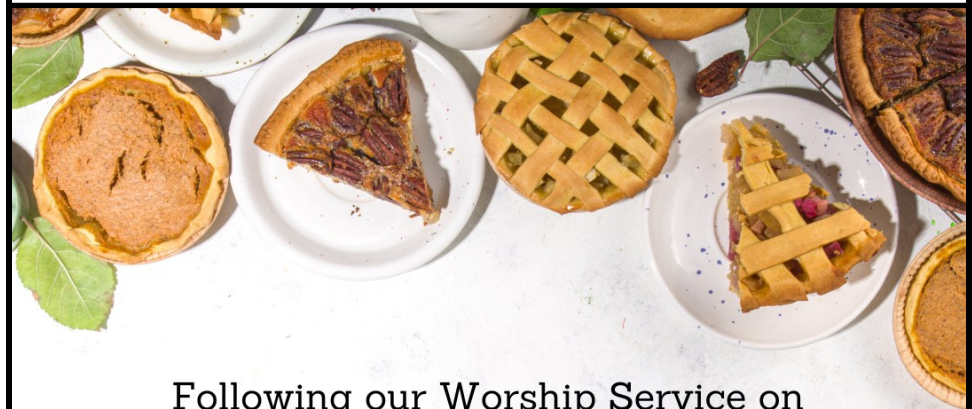
